



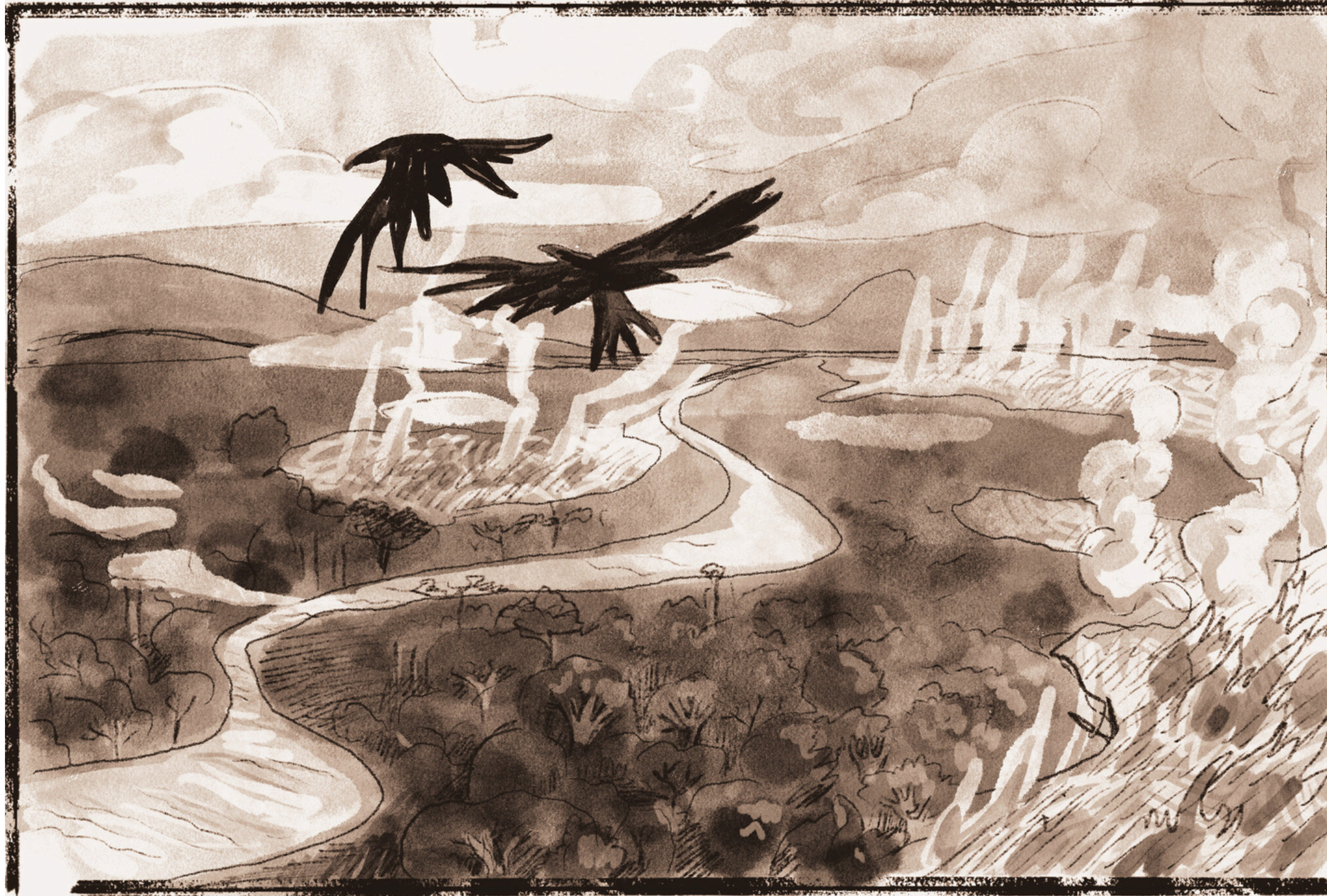

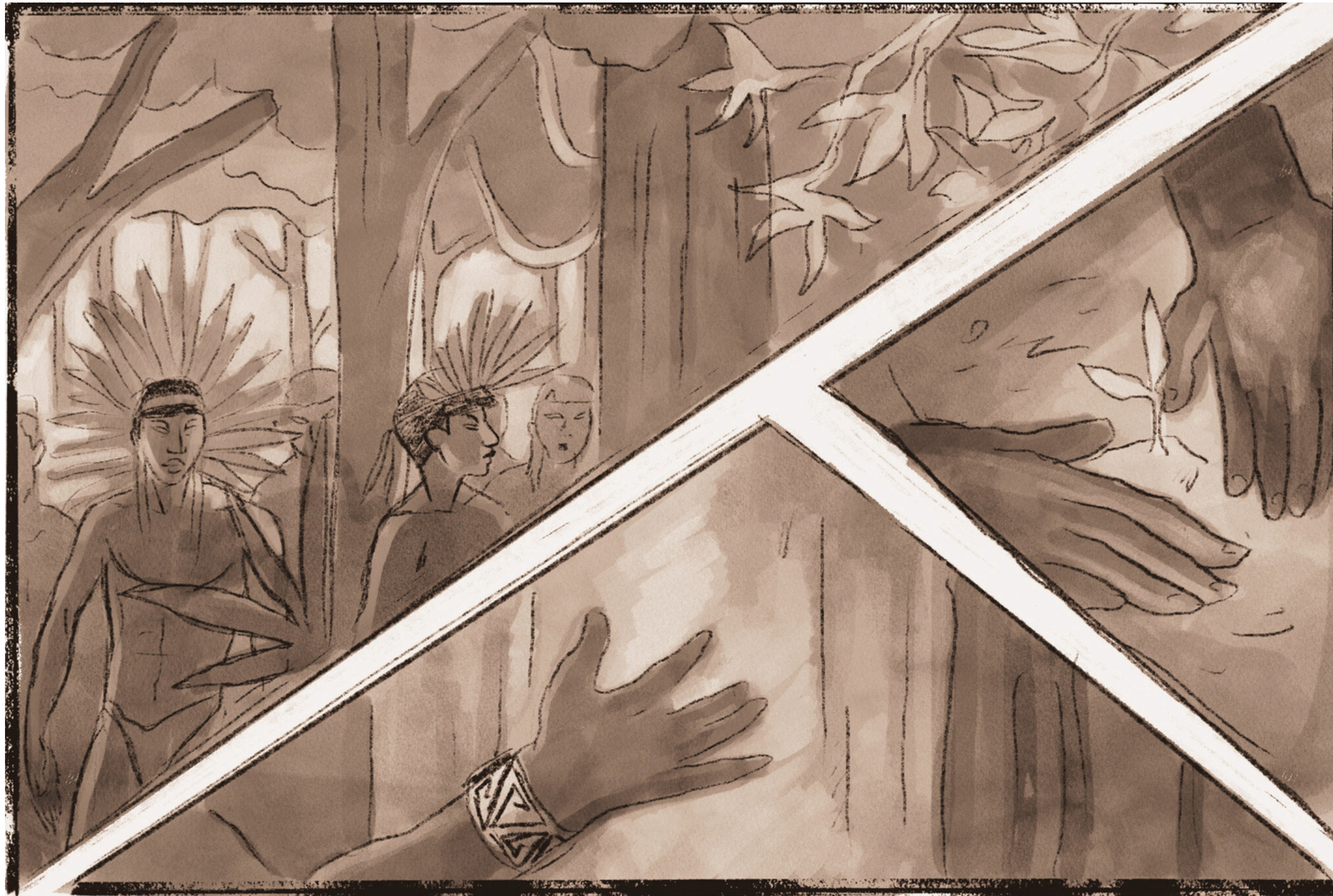
Opening Scene: A World at the Edge

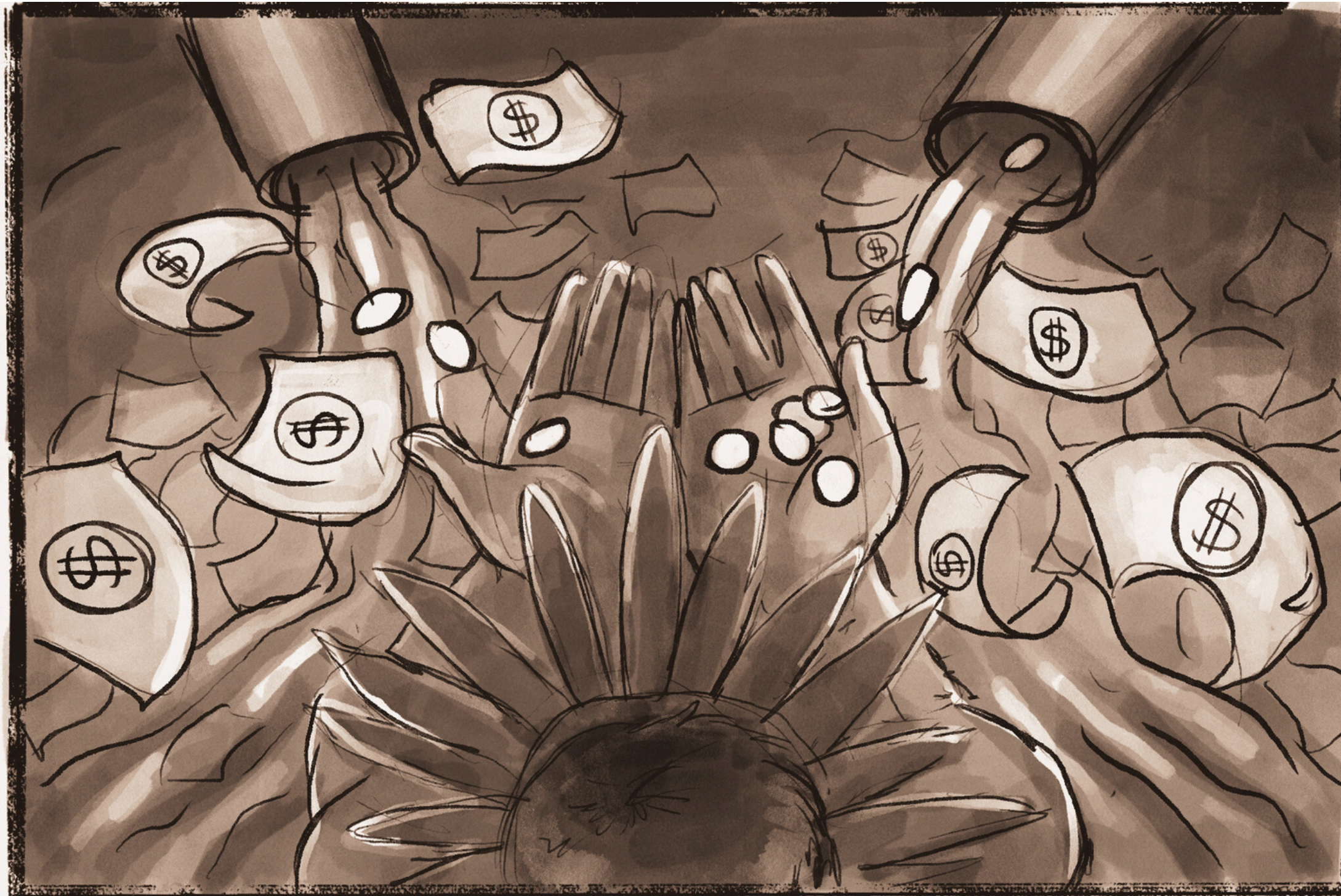
Act 1: The Guardians of Life

This is why we must revolutionize the way the world funds restoration."

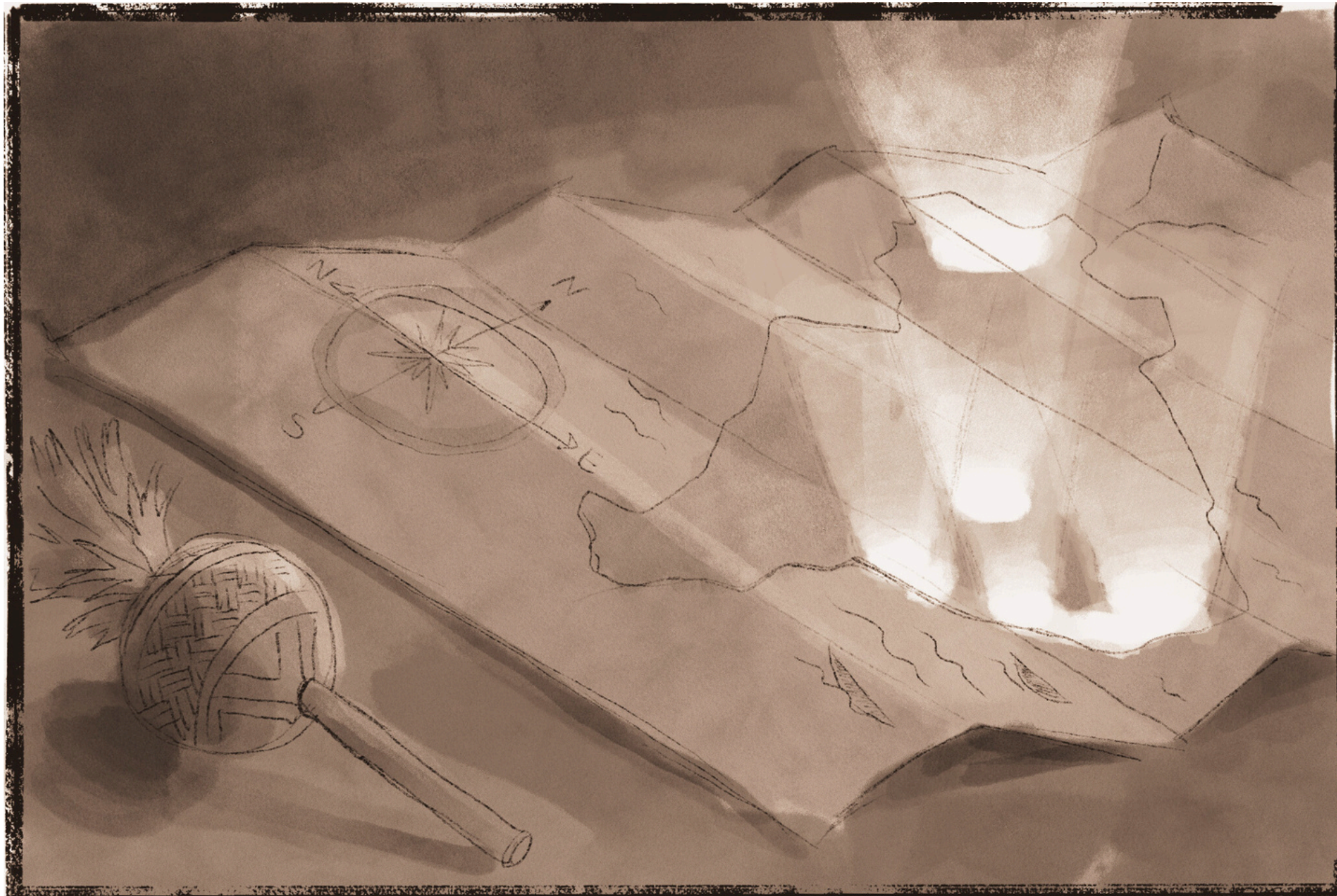

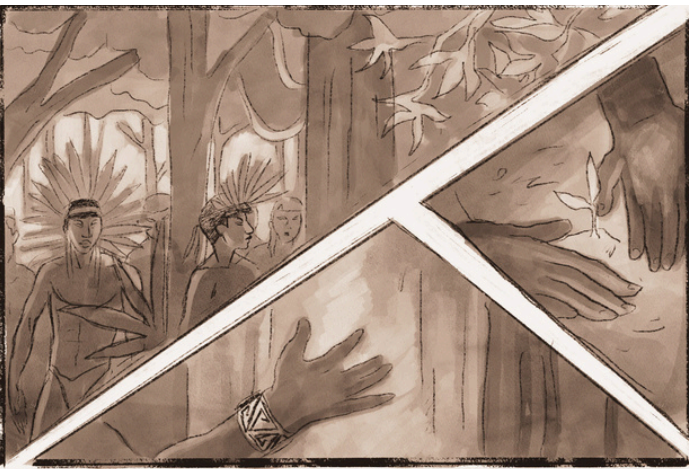

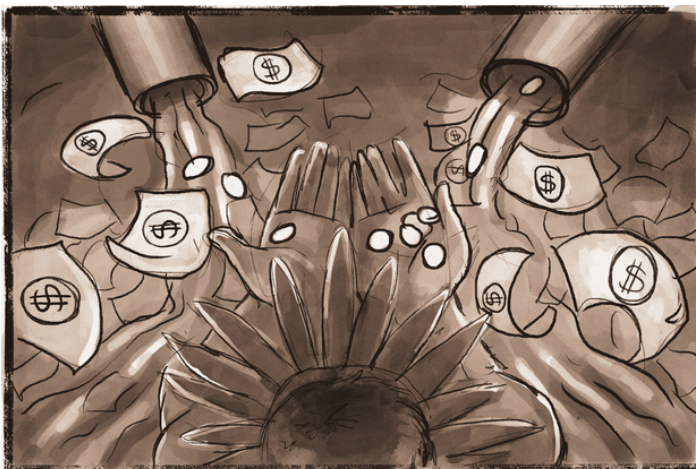
