Proposing an Indigenous-Centric Campaign

The Amazon acts as a “biotic pump” for our planet’s precipitation and regenerative agriculture/agroforestry

- The Amazon is our initial focus, and it is not just the planet’s left lung, but it’s **heart** – critical to the world’s precipitation patterns feeding the atmospheric rivers that the Indigenous consider sacred streams
- These rivers are essential for supporting rainfall on forests, irrigating agriculture systems, and feeding civilizations

Huge funding disparities exist:

- Yet **less than 7% of funds** promised at COP conferences reach IPLC. (Indigenous Peoples and Local Communities Forest Tenure Pledge)
- **Globally, they receive less than 1%** of global conservation funding (Funding with Purpose Report) – **an unacceptable funding gap ALL1 strives to close**

ALL1 for Amazonia Campaign Design

We propose working with leading organizations to design a **blended capital campaign**, as well as creating an ALL1.eco **digital funding platform** so that all Indigenous Peoples & Local Communities have an aggregate place to showcase their regenerative efforts.

The intention is to fund the initial development of the campaign and platform through philanthropy, **allowing 100% of distributable funds to go directly to grassroots funding initiatives.**

Currently we plan to pilot in four key bioregions in Amazonia & beyond.

- Design a biome regeneration blended-capital campaign
- Facilitate philanthropic and crowd-funding donations
- Provide direct campaign fundraising support for regenerative projects

STORYTELLING & EDUCATION

- Share learnings and success stories of regenerative projects

- Protect wisdom and lessons of Indigenous communities, projects and leaders.

- Build and back regenerative ventures driving the Amazonia bioeconomy
- Strengthen IPLC supply chains
- Support IPLC cooperatives with regenerative training and certification

Key Village to Village Pilot to Fund: Nukini Agroforestry Initiative

- Partnering with Aliança Reflorestar (Amazon Reforest Alliance) and their vision for a new pilot with the Nukini people of the Recanto Verde village, on the Moa River, in the municipality of Mâncio Lima, Acre, Brazil for the agroforestry planting of 5,000 trees in an already identified area
- Aliança Reflorestar has experience building alliances in agroforestry with Ashaninka, Yawanawa and Puyanawa Indigenous Peoples
- After several meetings with local leaders and active community outreach, the Aliança Reflorestar is seeking funding for the project:
 - Training in the collection and storage of native seeds
 - Purchase of equipment and tools
 - Agroforestry planting of 5,000 trees
 - Maintenance of the seedlings for two years
 - Knowledge exchange with other traditional peoples
 - Strengthening of local Indigenous Agroforestry Agents
- **We seek a \$50k lead gift** to fund this \$100k project over three years to pilot this important bioeconomy seed collection and nursery effort
- Design and test a 7 Trees grassroots crowdfunding campaign to support the pilot (*everyone requires 7 trees producing oxygen every month*)

Seeking \$150k to Fund the Nukini Agroforestry Pilot and ALL1.eco to Conduct a Campaign Planning Study



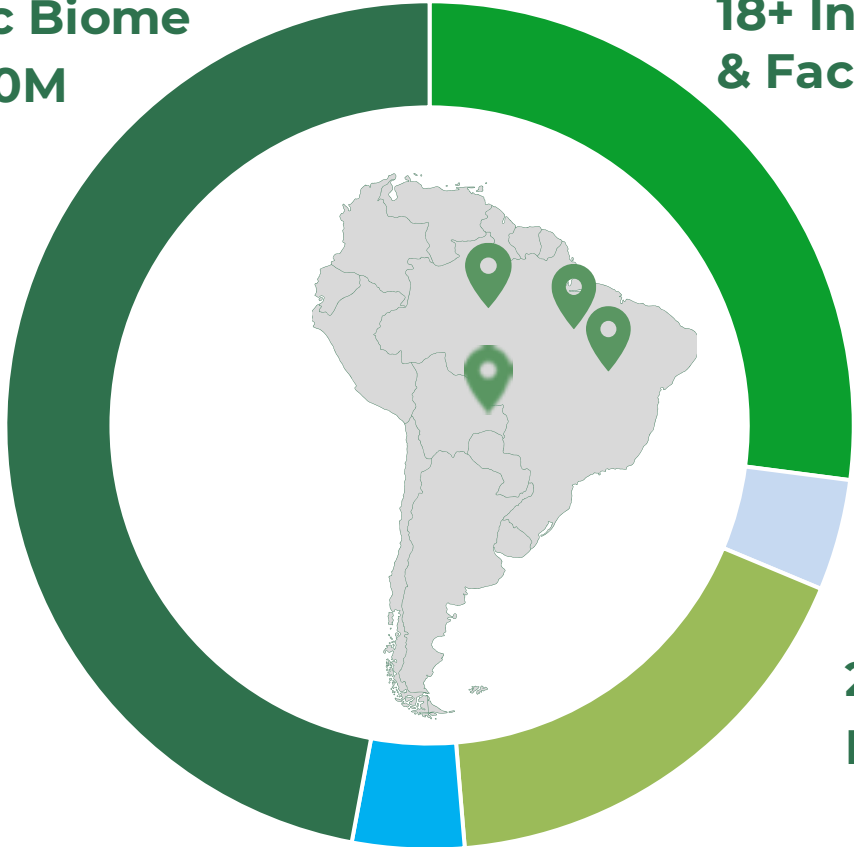
Design Phase – Campaign Planning (Winter-Spring 2026): \$250k

- \$50k lead gift to Nukini pilot project
- \$100k funds core team for four months:
 - Conduct feasibility study, develop campaign & communications plan and map ecosystem funding needs
 - Conduct study at several key gatherings including the Systemic Investing Summit April 14-16, 2026 in Rio de Janeiro
 - Design a 7 Trees grassroots crowdfunding campaign

Proposed ALL1 Governance Structure



ALL1 Community (all1community.eco)

- Led in reciprocity with Indigenous and spiritual leaders
- To be incorporated as **501(c)3 spiritual (religious) nonprofit**
- **Holding organization** which will own the IP of the PBC and receive **profits to circulate down to grassroots initiatives for regeneration**



ALL1.eco PBC, Inc. (all1.eco)

- Will channel funding to grassroots regenerative projects
- Registered **Public Benefit Corporation (PBC) to be majority owned by the nonprofit**
- Will raise capital to market and scale the fundraising portal



ALL1 Ventures, LLC (all1ventures.eco)

- Builds regenerative ventures that restore ecosystems, empower communities, drive net positive impact
- **For profit Limited Liability Corporation**
- Commercializes products sourced regeneratively from indigenous and forest dweller communities
