Ecosystem Collapse is Accelerating— Restoration Begins with **All as One**

The Amazon acts as a “biotic pump” for our planet’s precipitation

- The Amazon is critical to the world’s precipitation patterns and acts as a heart pumping and feeding the atmospheric rivers we consider sacred streams.
- These rivers are essential for supporting rainfall on other forests, irrigating agriculture systems, and feeding civilizations everywhere.

Our planet is at a critical juncture, facing rapid ecosystem collapse

- Accelerating Deforestation: Rainforests, vital carbon sinks and biodiversity hotspots, are experiencing unprecedented deforestation rates, threatening global climate stability.
- Indigenous communities not only curb deforestation but better restore deforested land in their territories than the privately owned and unincorporated lands around them. (PNAS 2023)
- By **empowering** Indigenous Peoples and Local Communities (IPLC) — the world’s most effective guardians of biodiversity — with **streamlined funding**, we can restore critical ecosystems and reshape global restoration.

Huge Funding Disparities exist:

- Yet **less than 7% of funds** promised at COP conferences reach IPLC. (Indigenous Peoples and Local Communities Forest Tenure Pledge)
- **Globally, they receive less than 1%** of global conservation funding (Funding with Purpose Report)– **an unacceptable funding gap ALL1 thrives to close.**

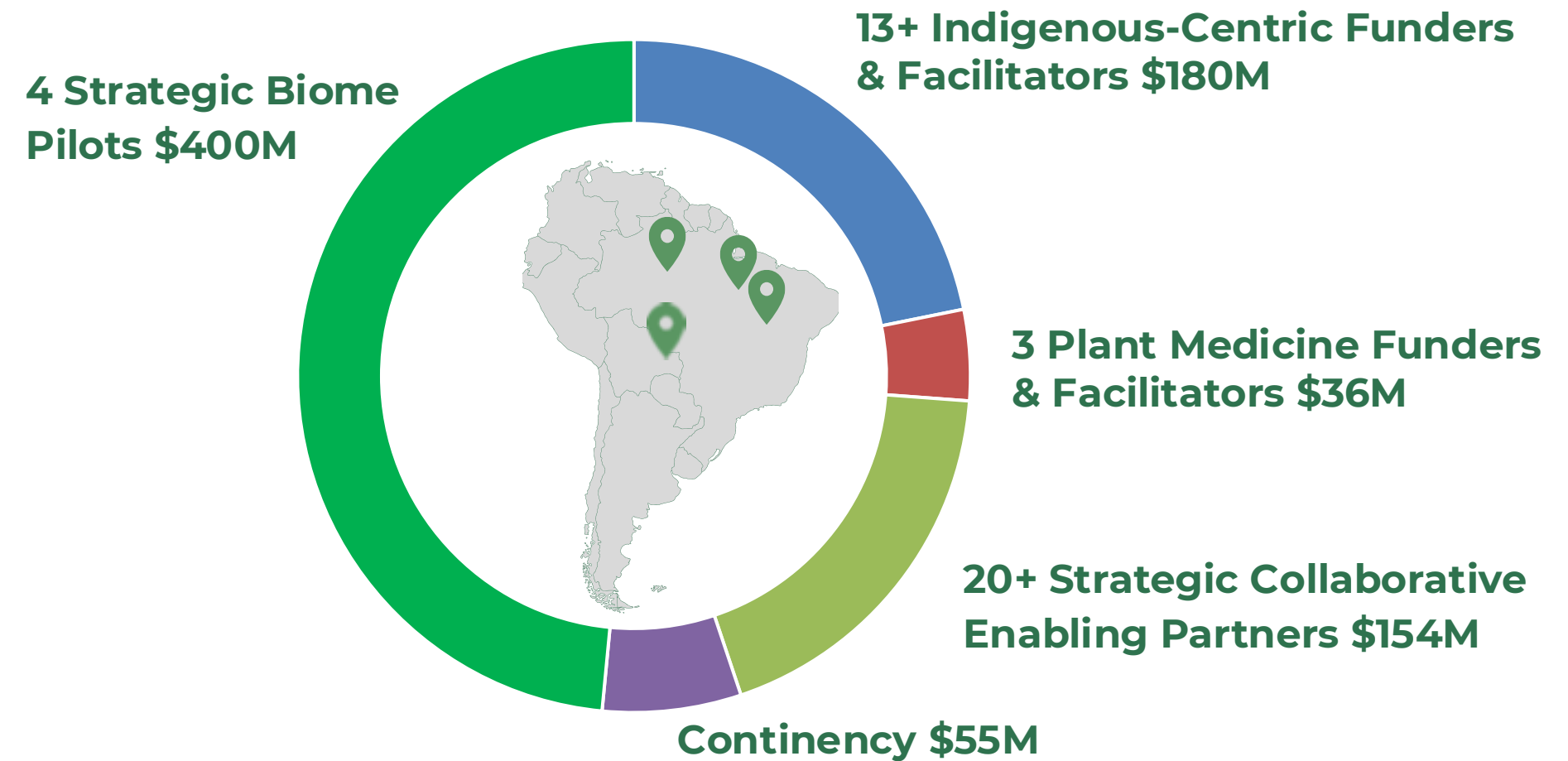

ALL1.eco Governance Structure



ALL1 Community (all1community.eco)

- Led by Indigenous and spiritual leaders
- To be incorporated as **501(c)3 spiritual (religious) nonprofit** in the U.S.
- **Holding organization** which will own the IP of the PBC and receive **profits to circulate down to grassroots initiatives for regeneration.**



ALL1.eco PBC, Inc. (all1.eco)

- Will channel funding to grassroots regenerative projects.
- Registered **Public Benefit Corporation (PBC) in New York to be majority owned by the nonprofit.**
- Will raise capital to market and scale the fundraising portal.



ALL1 Ventures, LLC (all1ventures.eco)

- Manages regenerative ventures and consulting opportunities.
- **For profit Limited Liability Corporation.**
- Promotes products sourcing ingredients from grassroots Indigenous regenerative projects.



The ALL1.eco Digital Funding Portal

A decentralized, transparent, and scalable funding portal designed to revolutionize restoration finance by connecting Indigenous-centric projects with global capital and key players.

Our intention is to fund the development of the portal and operations through philanthropy, **allowing 100% of distributable funds to go directly to grassroots funding initiatives.**

We plan to pilot in four key bioregions in the Amazon & beyond.

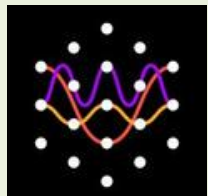
